Ontology: the study of what, fundamentally, exists in the world

Ontological scheme: a list of the fundmental categories of entities that is exhaustive — that is, every entity fits in somewhere on the list

A SAMPLE ONTOLOGICAL SCHEME:

- 1. Physical objects
- 2. Events
- 3. Laws of nature
- 4. Properties
- 5. Places and times
- 6. Mathematical objects (numbers, sets, etc.)
- 7. God
- 8. People
